

NEW LANDLORD OBLIGATIONS IN DENVER AS OF JANUARY 1, 2022

New leases

If a landlord is entering into a new rental agreement ("lease") with a tenant for more than 30 days, they must:

- 1. Put the lease in writing
- 2. Provide the tenant with a signed copy of the lease before the tenant moves in (and within 7 days of both parties having signed the lease)
- 3. Provide the tenant with this Tenant's Rights & Resources guide

Demand for Rent

If a landlord serves a Demand for Rent to any tenant, they must also provide the tenant with <u>this Tenant's</u> <u>Rights & Resources guide</u>

Penalties for violation

If the landlord does not comply, the city of Denver may issue administrative citations up to \$999 per day of the violation.
